



COVID-19 SECURITY MEASURES

The 1063AD organizers communicate that there are certain measures activated in Italy to contain the spread of Covid-19. They include the following:

- 1) To enter the Expo on Saturday, 18 of December, possession of a valid Italian Green Certification or European Union Green Pass is necessary.
- 2) To collect your race bib at the Expo you will have to show your per valid Italian Green Certification or European Union Green Pass.
- 3) For those coming from outside of the European Union proof of vaccination recognized by the EU or negative PCR or antigen test results will be required.
- 4) If someone will be collecting your race bib it will be necessary to show the required documents of the race participant, including either proof of vaccines or proof of a negative PCR or antigen test.
- 5) At the entrance to the Expo and the start area body temperatures will be measured. Your body temperature must be less than 37.5.
- 6) Protective masks must be worn inside the Expo area.
- 7) On race day in order to enter the departure zone, it is necessary to wear a protective mask.
- 8) The race will begin in waves to minimize risk. Athletes are required to wear a protective mask when starting for at least 500 meters.
- 9) At the finish line upon arrival, it is compulsory to wear a mask until exiting the delimited post-arrival area;
- 10) In all situations, be it during the Maratona di Pisa Expo or the day of the race, it is imperative to maintain social distancing.
- 11) All services, during and following the race must follow the competent authorities' rules. These rules are subject to change, therefore we invite all athletes to continue to monitor our website www.maratonadipisa.com
